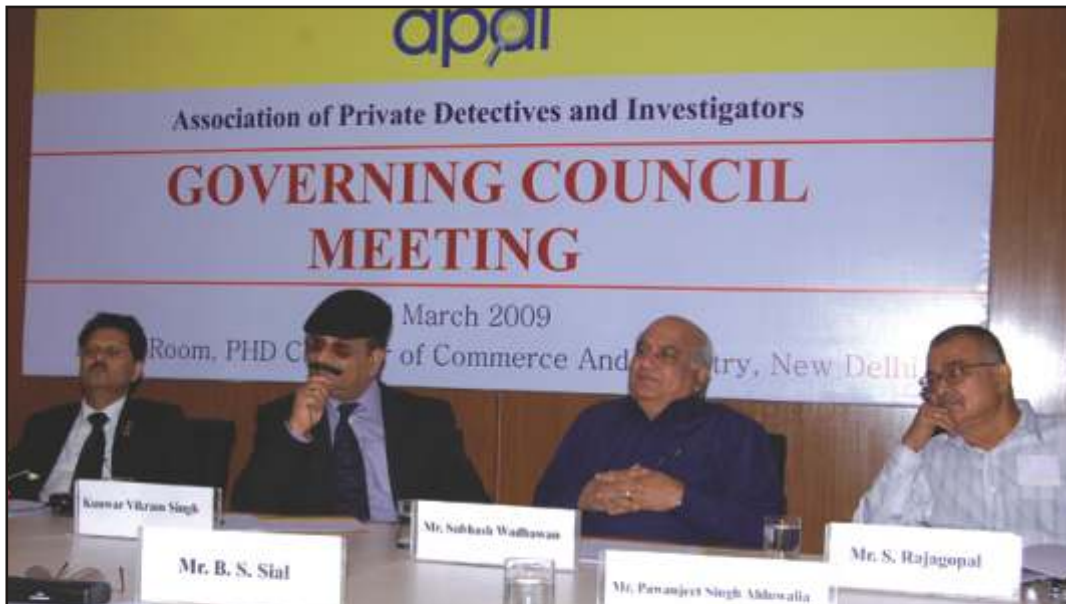

## Opening Address by the APDI Chairman



Kunwar Vikram Singh, Chairman during his opening address said that this is the first time; we are convening the separate Governing Council Meeting of APDI to deliberate more on the points amongst ourselves. It was felt that during the previous combined Governing Council Meetings of CAPSI & APDI, the weightage was more towards the points related to CAPSI activities as such this separate meeting has been organised. He further said that the report of Ms. Sushma Swaraj, Chairperson Standing Committee has been tabled in the Parliament on the PDAR Bill of 2007. We have been able to get a copy of the report and the same has been kept in the folders that have been given to all of you. He then apprised the members about the efforts that were put in by him and others during the year 2008. He further said that the main aim of this meeting is to discuss the strategies that are to be adopted in the light of the report submitted by the Chairperson, Standing Committee. He then requested Mr. Mahesh Sharma, Secretary General of the APDI to give the details of the activities during the year 2008 as per the agenda of the meeting.

## APDI Activities during the year 2008



Mr. Mahesh C Sharma apprised all with the activities of the APDI during the year 2008, covering the details of the memberships, meetings with the influential personalities and the appointments of the Chapter Chairmen, Conveners and the Governors with the basic

aim to enhance the image of the APDI all over the Country. He then requested Col. Trikha to continue with the deliberations of the agenda for the meeting.

## APDI Membership Structure

The type of APDI membership was discussed amongst the present members and various pros and cons were deliberated upon, but the house was of the views that the only individual membership be considered with the aim of attracting more agencies. The membership fee should be uniform and NOT based on the turn over of the agency as per the present practice, which came into force after the last Governing Council Meeting of CAPSI & APDI held on 16 June 2008 at New Delhi. Following decisions were taken unanimously:-

- (A) Individual Membership to be granted.
  - (b) Admission Fee. Rs. 5,000/- (One Time)\*
  - (c) Annual Membership Fee. Rs. 5,000/- only.\*
- \* Plus service tax as applicable.

## Image of the APDI

Kunwar Vikram Singh also pointed out that CAPSI has been projected very well during the past few years and the image is now established, but the APDI is now required to be projected well to attract the new members as such he will be focusing now more on the PR campaign for the APDI. Mr. Sachit Kumar, the Chairman of the APDI- PR Committee will assist the National Chairman in this campaign during the year 2009.

## Sial For Detailed Background Checks



Mr. B S Sial, Governor APDI, discussed about the quality of background check of the potential members before granting the APDI memberships to them as the background check is of paramount importance for

the well being of the association. There fore, it should be considered as an important factor for grant of membership. It was then decided that the Chairman of the Membership Committee, Mr. Subhash Wadhawan, will be responsible for the same and the secretariat will send all the applications to him for his recommendations for the grant of APDI membership.

## Standing Committee Report on the PDAR Bill 2007

Kunwar Vikram Singh then talked about the report submitted by Ms. Sushma Swaraj, Chairperson of the standing committee on the PDAR Bill 2007. He said that the report is very comprehensive and the PDAR Bill 2007 has not been considered for rejection by the committee but has been recommended for re look at the various clauses of the Bill by the chairperson of the standing committee. Now, that the elections have been announced, as such no decisions will be taken. He then recommended forming a sub committee to study the PDAR Bill 2007 in the light of the report tabled in the Parliament. The decision was appreciated by every one and it was decided that the secretariat will inform the details of the members of this Committee, who will deliberate further and submit a comprehensive report to be sent to the new government at centre after the forthcoming elections.

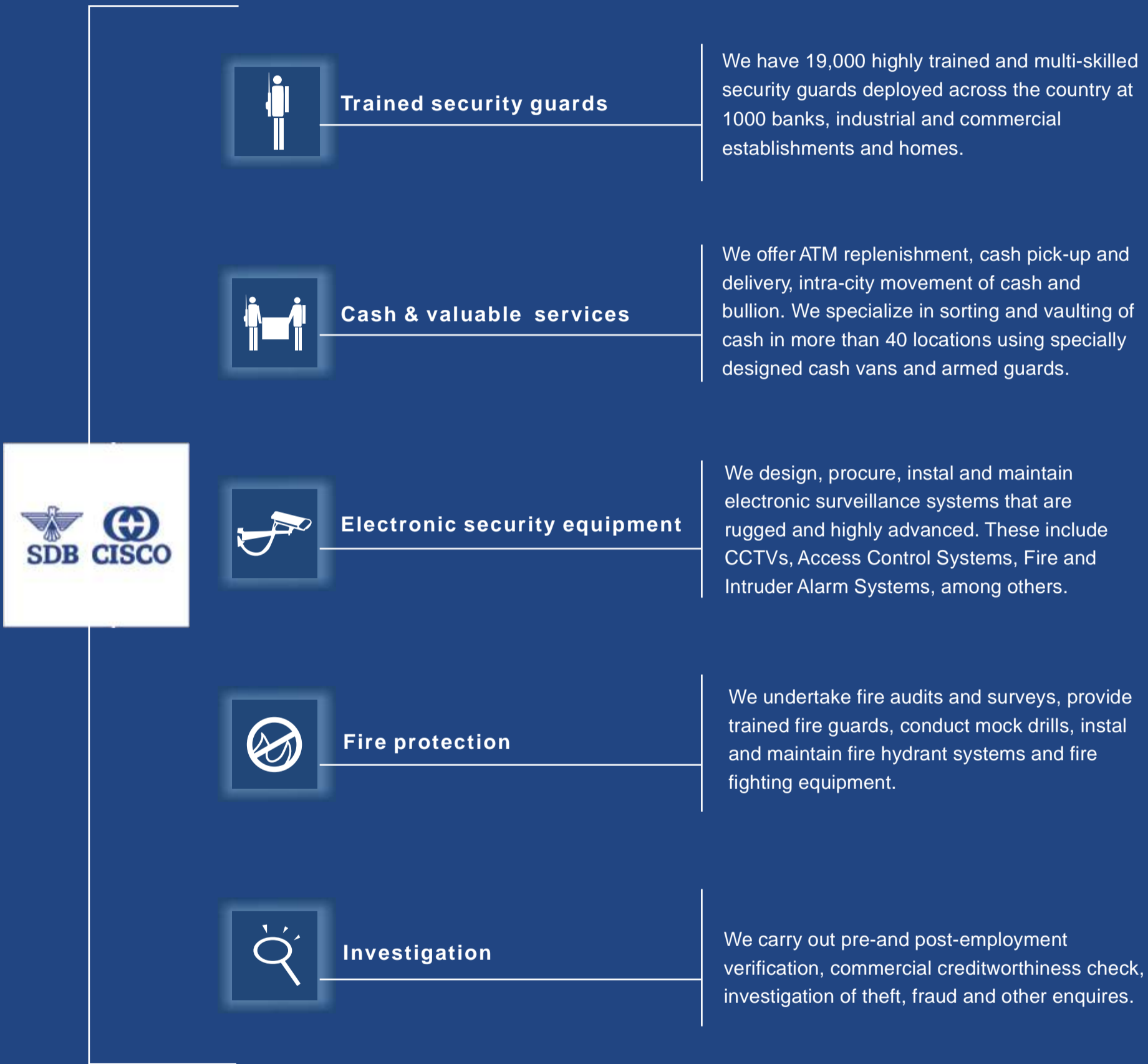

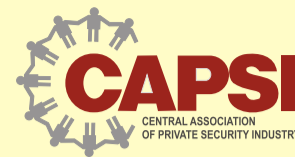
